Joint Core Strategy for Broadland, Norwich and South Norfolk:

Adoption Statement 24 March 2011

In accordance with Regulations 24 and 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 (Amended 2008), notice is hereby given that on 22 March 2011 South Norfolk Council formally resolved to adopt the Joint Core Strategy for Broadland, Norwich and South Norfolk. The plan forms part of the Local Development Framework for South Norfolk. It contains strategic policies covering the period 2008-2026 and replaces relevant parts of the South Norfolk Local Plan (Replacement) (Adopted 2003) and its Proposals Maps. The plan area is the districts of Broadland, Norwich and South Norfolk, excluding those areas administered by the Broads Authority.

The Joint Core Strategy DPD was considered by an independent Inspector and an Assistant Inspector as part of a Public Examination, with hearings held between 9 November and 9 December 2010. The Inspectors' report was published on 25 February 2011 and concluded that the Joint Core Strategy DPD was 'sound', subject to a number of required changes. The adopted Joint Core Strategy and Proposals Maps incorporate the binding recommendations of the Inspector.

Any person who is aggrieved by the adoption of the Joint Core Strategy for Broadland, Norwich and South Norfolk may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning & Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate powers of the local authorities and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made promptly and no later than 6 weeks after the date on which the Joint Core Strategy for Broadland, Norwich and South Norfolk was adopted, i.e by **5 May 2011**.
