Dear Participant

Further to my letter last week announcing the date of the Pre-Hearing Meeting (PHM), the Inspectors have now decided that as a result of the response they have received from the Greater Norwich Development Partnership to their earlier questions, it would be beneficial to have a public exploratory meeting (EM) with the GNDP on certain issues.

The date for this will be 13<sup>th</sup> May which is the same date as the PHM at 10.00 at the King's Centre, King Street, Norwich, Norfolk NR1 1PH. The procedural subject matter of the PHM will not take up much time and, if necessary, can be slotted in comfortably after the exploratory meeting.

More details of any alternate time and the agenda for the EM will be circulated on or about Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> May. However, the broad subject matter of the meeting will be as follows:

- Infrastructure
- Affordable Housing
- The NDR
- The distribution of new development in relation to the maximisation of public transport opportunities, particularly whether or not the chosen distribution will enable turn-up-and-go services to be provided, and when.
- Sustainability issues
- Whether or not the JCS provides sufficient information about the planning of the growth triangle, given that some significant points in the GNDP reply to the Inspector's Q19 (particularly, but not only, concerning overall coordination) are not evident from reading the JCS.
